Creating a healthy and safe environment for all our attendees, sponsors, presenters, staff, and students is of the utmost importance as we plan for our fall event in Hyde Park. The following information is based on current guidance and may not reflect the requirements or recommendations that will be in place in October. However, we are consistently monitoring all federal, state, and Dutchess County guidance and will update this page regularly to reflect the most current recommendations and regulations.

Health & Safety Protocols, as of September 2021

Participants must provide:

- Proof of full COVID-19 vaccination; OR
- Proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours from the time of entry

Details on submitting your entry requirement will be provided in mid-September for those who have already registered.

Venue Safety & Mask Requirement

- As of September 2021:
 - Regardless of vaccination status, masks are currently required in all indoor public locations at the CIA. Exceptions for tasting will be communicated at programs, and attendees will be permitted to remove masks when seated at a dining program.
 - At all times, service staff will be wearing masks both indoors and outdoors.
- CIA Hyde Park restaurants are outfitted with [Bluezone](#)[®] air purification systems, which include a patented solution to kill 99.99% of airborne viruses and bacteria.
- The CIA continues to implement increased frequency of cleaning and sanitizing in all public spaces. Hand sanitizing stations are available throughout campus.
